This is fresh, floral, minerally and sherbetty and this particular bottling is still showing the faintest hint of residual sulphur on the nose also. Very clean on the palate though, with a firm mousse. It has a good, precise, well defined style with good fruit acidity. There is both substance and flavour here and very good potential.

In the late 19th century this champagne was decorated with the famous red ribbon, as a tribute to Legion d'Honneur. The decoration became the hallmark of one of the world's most renowned champagnes. The palate has complex fresh fruit and caramel flavours.

Deutz Marlborough Cuvee Rose

Marries premium cool – climate grapes with traditional Champagne techniques to craft a sophisticated and elegant method traditionnelle.

This rose wine, crafted predominantly from Pinot Noir grapes, is fresh and vibrant, combining toasty yeast flavours with aromas of summer berry fruits.

Kim Crawford Flowers Marlborough 08 \$62 \$15

Very fragrant and aromatic on the nose, firm acidity is rounded out with the delicious taste of ripe passionfruit and other tropical fruits on the palate.

Man O'War Waiheke Island 08 \$53 \$13.5

The palate shows a rich concentration of flavours with a well balanced vibrant acidity and fresh finish. This wine is best enjoyed with fresh fish and summer salads or as an aperitif.

Redoubt Hill Nelson 09 \$48.5 \$12.5

Single vineyard vintage

The vineyard is situated in the beautiful Motueka Valley near the Able Tasman national park. All the fruit is gently hand picked then bunch pressed, which is reflected in the clarity and quality of this wine.

Catalina Sounds Marlborough 09 \$46.5 \$12

The nose exhibits distinct aromas of fresh fruit salad, passionfruit, citrus lime and floral spice, continuing onto a palate that has a rich, soft mouth feel, with underlying acidity that gives length and a clean finish.

Wild Rock "Elevation" Marlborough 08 \$46.5 \$12

Bright aromas of lemongrass, lime, herbs, grapefruit, viognier spice and spring flowers. The palate is juicy yet elegant in structure, with a fine tincy texture and a beautiful array of citrus and sweet herb flavours with a delicate floral note.

Stoneleigh Marlborough 09 \$49.5 \$12.5

A well know New Zealand Sauvignon, which displays tropical, passionfruit and citrus flavours emphasised by the wine maker, by controlling skin contact.

Couper's Shed Marlborough 09 \$44 \$11

This highly aromatic Sauvignon Blanc has intense passionfruit, citrus, and red capsicum characters. Concentrated in flavour, this wine is crisp and refreshing with a lingering lime citrus finish.

Drylands Marlborough 08 \$44 \$11

A rich bouquet of gooseberry and passion fruit fill the nose while your palate is tantalized by rich, ripe tropical and herbal flavors. Intense gooseberry and passion fruit result in a vibrant burst of flavor.

Bensen Block Marlborough 08 \$39.5 \$10

The palate exhibits intense tropical and capsicum flavours, with aromas of pungent gooseberry, snow pea and passionfruit.

Settlers Hill Marlborough 09 \$32 \$9

A medium bodied wine with fresh primary fruit characters and a clean crisp acid finish which displays good length.

Trinity Hills Hawkes Bay 08 \$61 \$15.5

The standout feature is the texture of this wine, the opulent mouth-feel and bouquet of nashi pear and spice make this wine luscious and popular.

Mt Difficulty Central Otago 08 \$54 \$13.5

The warm dry of the vintage has resulted in aromas of white peach blossom mingled with Bon Chretien pear. The palate displays luscious fruit in the same vein, while the mid palate is full, creamy and well textured.

Man O'War Waiheke Island 08 \$54 \$13.5

Aromas of apricots and lime cordial combine with subtle yeast autolysis characters reminiscent of a fine Champagne. The palate is poised between balances of fine acidity, a hint of natural sweetness and a pleasing tonic like finish.

Triplebank Marlborough 09 \$52 \$13

This wine displays the typical pear and rock melon that makes this variety so sought after, with a creamy texture and tropical fruit flavours.

Stoneleigh Marlborough 08 \$45 \$12.5

Soft, fruity wine with typical pear and lanolin flavours. A suggestion of sweetness contributes to the wine's creamy texture. A delicate and appealing wine that been made using a light touch.

PINOT NOIR

Camshorn Waipara 07 \$77

Camshorn winery sits sheltered from winds by hills on both sides. A generous palate displaying wild berry and chocolate, integrated with notes of herb and lingering cracked pepper.

Coalpit "Tiwha" Gibbston Central Otago 06 \$63 \$16

This wine has a spicy, herbal bouquet intermingled with Black Doris plums, cherries and raspberries. It is a well structured wine, packed full of fruit with good tannin weight and structure.

Kim Crawford Rise & Shine Creek 07 \$62 \$15 Central Otago

Wonderful complexity of ripe dark fruits, hints of game, spice and toasty oak on the nose, followed by a silky tannin structure and oak influence combine in a lengthy satisfying finish.

Mt Difficulty Roaring Meg \$61 \$15.5

Central Otago 08

Produced in New Zealand's premier region for Pinot Noir, this wine exhibits a lovely mix of red and blackberry fruits with further complexity gained from oak spice.

Kumeu River Village Auckland 08 \$51 \$12.5

A delicate, smooth and velvety wine with ripe berry aromas together with the maturation complexity gained from careful ageing in small oak barrels.

Stoneleigh Marlborough 08 \$49.5 \$12.5

This wine has a deep ruby red hue. The bouquet is fragrant, with black cherry, raspberry and red plums overlaid with savoury toasty spice.

Drylands Marlborough 08 \$44 \$11

The wine displays a fruit driven aroma of cherry with a seasoning of fresh clean oak. The palate exhibits lifted sweet fruit with velvety tannins and subtle oak to add complexity.

SHIRAZ

Jacobs Creek Reserve 06 \$44 \$11

South Australia Shiraz

This Shiraz is full bodied with velvety tannins which provide the perfect backbone for expression of spicy Shiraz flavours.

Wyndham Estate Bin 555. 07 \$39.5 \$10

Southern Eastern Australia Shiraz

Bin 555 Shiraz from Wyndham Estate is a super-value red from Australia's Hunter Valley. This medium-bodied Shiraz offers bright fruit-forward flavors of plums and strawberry.

Montana Reserve Marlborough 06 \$53.5 \$13.5

Aromas of sweet boysenberry, cassis and black plum with earthy chocolate and vanilla spice cascade into black plum and sweet boysenberry fruit, matched with spicy vanilla and savoury oak notes.

Stoneleigh Marlborough 07 \$49.5 \$12.5

Bright ruby red hue, with a fragrant bouquet of blackberry, mocha, spice and subtle hints of toasted oak.

This wine has rich flavours of black plum and berry fruit with a hint of spicy oak to add complexity.

Church Road Merlot Cabernet 07 **\$56** **\$14**

Hawkes Bay

This wine was created by using traditional Bordeaux winemaking techniques. A complex and dry red wine with rich berry fruit characters and a long and ripe finish.

Huntaway Merlot Cabernet Gisborne 07 **\$53.5** **\$13.5**

Huntaway's reserve winemaker crafted this wine from predominately Gisborne grapes. The result is an approachable wine that has a medium bodied palate with ripe plum and blackcurrant flavours and integrated cherry oak.

Wild Rock "Gravel Pit Red" 07 **\$46.5** **\$12**

Hawkes Bay Gimblett Gravels Vineyard

Aromatically profuse with dollops of black doris plum and blackberry. It has been laced with cedar, dark chocolate and thyme. The palate is thick with fine soft tannins that meld with abundant, ripe fruit.

Settlers Hill Merlot Cabernet 07 **\$32** **\$9**

An approachable mid-weight palate which is reinforced by a medley of dark-fruit aromas from blackcurrant to black plum.

Pre fermentation maceration gives good colour and fruit tannin extraction. Fermentation and aging in French oak barriques provides complexity, a lifted aroma, structure and integrated soft tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon

The 2006 vintage cabernet reflects the renowned characteristics of the coonawarra. A rich round palate with plum and dark cherry flavours and a lingering spicy oak finish. Crafted for drinking now.
